

Scarlet Rose Necklace Instructions

Time to Fully Complete Project: 30-60 minutes.

Dimensions: The pendant is 3" long. The necklace is 18" long.

Tips: Using a silver box chain or link chain can give the necklace an elegant look. Try satin ribbon for a more feminine feel. Leather cording can make the necklace a more casual. If you want your pendant to be longer use a longer cable chain and add more swarovski and leaf beads to it.

- 1 18" long sterling silver chain finished with clasp. (optional)
- 1 lampwork sculpted red rose bead
- 1 3" sterling silver soft round wire 22ga, or 3" headpin
- 1 6-7mm sterling silver bead cap
- 8 6mm garnet red bicone swarovski crystal beads
- 7 6mm tourmaline green bicone swarovski crystal beads
- 7 8-10mm tourmaline green leaf beads
- 1 3mm sterling silver ball bead
- 1 1" to 1 1/2" of about 2.7mm sterling silver cable chain or chain 7 links long.
- 7 2" sterling silver headpins 22-24 ga
- 14 1 1/2" sterling silver headpins 22-24 ga

Tools: Needle nose pliers, crimping pliers, and wire cutters.

Instructions in Numbered Order:

Step #1 Use the needle nose pliers to make a loop at the end of the wire 3” wire. Add the 1” cable chain to the loop of the wire (photo 1). Twist the wire around and cut off the excess wire with the wire cutters (photo 2).

Step #2 Add one red swarovski bead, the bead cap, the sculpted rose bead, and one silver ball bead to the wire pendant (photo 3). Use the same loop technique in step #1 to make the loop for the top of the pendant (photo 4). Make the loop large enough for the necklace to fit though. Cut off the excess wire with the wire cutters.

Step #3 Assemble the leaf beads on the cable chain. The chain should have about 7 chain links. If it doesn’t have 7 links just space out the leaf beads evenly (photo 5). Take one 2” headpin and add one leaf bead to it. Use the same loop technique in step #1 to make a loop and attach it the first link in cable chain (photo 6). Cut off access wire. Repeat 6 times adding a leaf bead to each of the links in the cable chain (photo 7).

Step #4 To finish the pendant add the swarovski beads to the cable chain. Take one 1” headpin and add one swarovski bead to it. Use the same loop technique in step #1 to make a loop and attach it the cable chain (photo 8). Cut off access wire. Repeat 13 times adding one red and one green swarovski beads to each of the links in the cable chain (photo 9). Attaching all the swarovski beads can be a tight fit. Use your leaf beads as a guide to the chain links.

Step#5. Run the pendant thought the 18” chain and your necklace is ready to wear (photo 10).
