

Scarlet Earrings Instructions

Time to Fully Complete Project: 15-40 minutes.

Dimensions: The earrings are 1 7/8" long.

Tips:

Materials List:

- 2 red rose bud lampwork beads
- 2 sterling silver ear wires
- 2 3" sterling silver round wire 22ga.
- 6 6mm garnet red bicone swarovski crystal beads
- 2 8-10mm tourmaline green leaf beads
- 2 4x6mm sterling silver bead caps
- 2 3mm sterling silver ball beads
- 2 2" sterling silver headpins 22-24 ga
- 4 1" sterling silver headpins 22-24 ga

Tools: Needle nose pliers, crimping pliers, and wire cutters.

Instructions in Numbered Order:

Step #1 Use the needle nose pliers to make a loop at the end of the 3" wire (photo 1). Twist the wire around and cut off the excess wire with the wire cutters (photo 2).

Step #2 Next add to one red swarovski bead, one bead cap, one red rose bud lampwork bead, and one silver ball bead to the wire with the loop at the bottom (photo 3).

Step #3 Use the same loop technique in step #1 to make the loop for the top of the earring (photo 4). Place the ear wire in the loop before twisting the wire around and cutting off the excess wire with the wire cutters (photo 5).

Step #4 To attach the swarovski and leaf beads to the earring take one 2" headpin and add one leaf bead to it. Use the same loop technique in step #1 to make a loop and attach it to the bottom loop on the earring (photo 6). Cut off the excess wire with the wire cutters. Take two 1" headpin and add one swarovski bead to each headpin. Use the same loop technique in step #1 to make a loop and attach the swarovski beads to the bottom loop on the earring (photo 7). Cut off the excess wire with the wire cutters. Make sure the leaf bead is in the middle. Repeat step #1-4 to make the matching earring, and the earrings are ready to wear (photo 8).

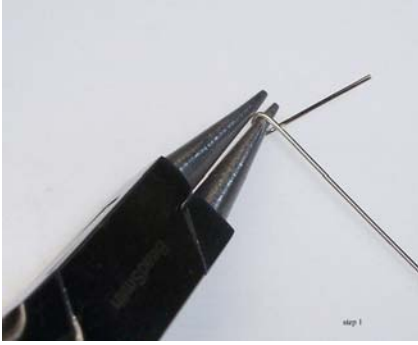
